FREE BREAKFAST IN BALTIMORE

The Baltimore Chapter of the Black Panther Party initiated its Breakfast Program at St. Martin de Porres Recreation Hall, at Valley and Eager Streets.

At the present time the Black Panthers are feeding 150 to 170 children on a daily basis. Due to the bad transit system, here in Baltimore it is necessary for the Black Panther Party to bus 50% of the children in to the Breakfast Program. It is evident that the community is in favor of this program by the amount of children that

are being fed.

We will continue this program throughout the summer into the coming school year. However, we will feed twice as many this summer; instead of a Breakfast Program, we will have a lunch program during the summer.

It is the goal of the Black Panther Party to feed all of the hungry children in Maryland. A second recreation hall was donated to the people by a revolutionary attorney, Mrs. Lena Lee, also a legislator in the state of Maryland. This hall

will be used to feed children, conduct classes in Business Administration, Law and hold rallies for our young people. Also in the same block the Black Panther Party will manage a revolutionary movie. At our first showing, we will have "Off The Pig" and "Huey".
