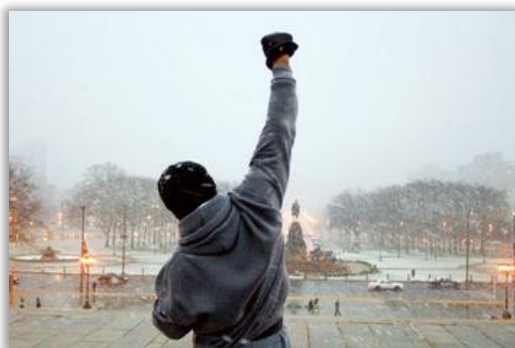
This is a free workshop. There is no registration fee.

There are no stipends available for this workshop.

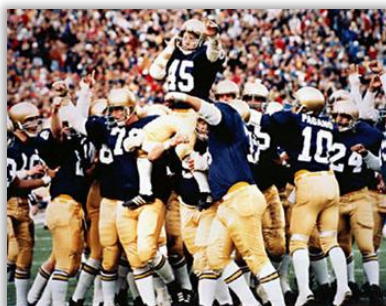
### ***More than a Game: American Sports in the Movies***
