

The automobile is not alone responsible for the fame which has come to Henry Ford. He is also esteemed for his terse epigrammatic sayings which convey accurately the philosophy underlying his life and work. During your inspection of the Rotunda you may have noted many of these maxims on the walls:

The farm and the shop each needs what the other produces

Wages for producers . . . profits to make greater value for users

A cheaply made product is too expensive to be priced cheaply

Raising food, making tools, transportation . . . three basic jobs

Over-production is a money cry, not a human cry . . . produce ever more

It is individualism that makes co-operation worth having

The recovery we need: American spirit of energy and independence

If we had more justice, there would be less need of charity

Industry does not support people . . . people support industry

High wages, best materials are the only road to lower prices If you stabilize anything it is likely to be the wrong thing It is not good business unless both buyer and seller gain by it Never has enough of any good thing been produced for use The auto made roads, and roads make commerce and civilization Progress comes from prosperity built by work . . . done in peace With one foot on the land and one in industry America is safe Industry is mind using matter to make man's life more free One-third of a century of progress
