

Of Behaviour in the School

1. Bow at coming in, Putting off thine hat; especially if the Master or Usher be present.
2. Loiter not, but immediately take thine own seat; and move not from one place to another, till School time be over.
3. If any stranger come into the School, rise up and bow, and sit down in thy space again, keeping a profound silence.
4. If the Master be discoursing in the School with a stranger stare not confidently on them, nor hearken to their talk.
5. Interrupt not the Master while a stranger or a visitant is with him, with any question, request or complaint; but defer any such matter till he be at leisure.
6. At no time talk or quarrel in the School; but be quiet, peaceable, and silent: Much less mayest thou deceive thy self by trifling away thy time in play.
