

Write Martin Luther King Jr. a Letter

Your task is to write a letter to Martin Luther King Jr. a letter to tell him about how civil rights for all have progressed since he died in 1968. Be sure to include each point listed below in your letter. Check off each point as you complete it.

- Introduce yourself to MLK by telling him who you are; age, grade, gender, race, school you go to, where you live, some interesting details about you as a person, and a little about your family. 10 pts.
- Tell MLK what you think of civil rights, prejudice, stereotypes and how they have affected you. 5 pts.
- Tell MLK what you think about his involvement in the Civil Rights Movement. Do you agree with his ideals? Why or why not? 5 pts.
- Compare today to MLK's time and before. Is there segregation? Is so, what kind? Who does it affect? Is it different than 1968 and the time of Jim Crow? How? 10 pts.
- Tell MLK how you can help our country to be fairer and less prejudice. 5 pts.
- Add anything else you would want MLK to know. 5 pts.
