Walter Kronkite

Dec. 2, 1963

Dear Mr. Kronkite;

It is strange that since President Kennedy's assassination you and certain other commentators repeatedly state that we have no use for "rightists or leftists. Why don't you present the facts to the American people?"

A Communist and pro-Castro person killed the President, not a so-called rightest or leftist.
