1. In order to prepare a 1st Draft of List of Target Organizations of Communist infiltration, both ideological and physical, we need current 1960 news clips about the 40 enclosed LIST.
2. You will note the same NAMES of leading people who appear in news items about the 40 organizations - appearing again and again;
3. Please clip - and mount with rubber cement on sheets of paper - and write or type at the top of each sheet the name of the PERSON or ORGANIZATION referred to in the news clip;

DO NOT FORGET TO mark down the name of the paper, date, page on the news clip or the sheet it is mounted on;
4. News clips - show either lists of names of Organizations; or quotes from key leadership NAME people stating their views on current issues, or the views of the Organization itself;
5. It is very important to clip the DAILY ILLINI in addition to the 2 city papers of C-U.
6. 30 days of news clips will provide the materials we need for an up-to-date coverage on the 40 key ORGANIZATIONS and the key leadership people in these groups;
7. Editorials - Radio or TV monitoring reports - are also needed to show the tenor and trend of the Mass media coming into the community.
8. To have a working tool - out of this Mimeo. LIST we are working on - we need all the new leads - your suggestions -- so send in - in writing - all ideas, names, information - and it will have to be checked and evaluated and set down in usable form; we will get out later Drafts but the 1st one must be as completely up to date as possible.; ready by April 1st.
9. If we get several copies of the same clip - we will use them all; also, we will get many ideas set down alongside the clips as they come to people's MINDS. Let your memory supply additional facts not in news clips about people and Organizations as to past activities and stands and views. Only a few people are working on this project so I am counting on your help.
