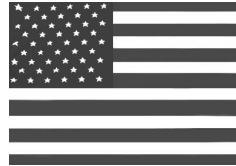


**WHO'S AFRAID OF THE

- How citizens can take action

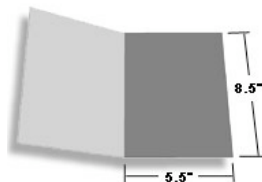
**Don't forget:**

- **Provide facts to back up your position on Communism**

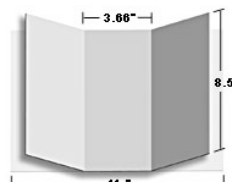
Types of Pamphlets

- Bi-fold: Fold your paper in half like a card. You have 4 sides of paper to fill.
- Tri-fold: Fold your paper into 3 even sections like it is a letter you will put in an envelope. You have 6 sides of paper to fill.
