The following students were selected as the top player in their section: **Junior Level Band:** Kameron LeShoure - bass clarinet, Annie Valocci - bassoon; **Senior Level Vocal Jazz:** Molly Netter - soprano; **Senior Level Band:** Christina Byrne - clarinet, Alex Chin - horn, Peter Deal - trombone, Chris Keeley - bassoon, Elise Nieman - flute, Emily Ward - oboe; **Senior Level Orchestra Winds:** Samantha Schwartz - piccolo/flute. Students at the Senior Level who placed the highest in their section has the potential to be selected for IMEA All-State, which will be held in Peoria in January, 2006.
