

Urbana School District #116 Board of Education Synopsis
Special Meeting March 23, 2009

The special meeting of the Urbana School District #116 Board of Education Meeting was called to order at 12:02 p.m., by Board President Mark Netter. There were six in attendance. Member Cope Cumpston was absent.

The board of education approved three reduction in force (RIF) resolutions for certified teachers, support personnel, and adult education workers. By law the school board must notify educators within 60 days of the end of school whether or not they'll be employed for the next school year. However, the state budget is not set until AFTER the end of the school year, so teachers and others whose salary is dependent on state monies have to be RIFed. If the state aid comes through for the fall, the teachers will be rehired. The board voted 6-0 to approve the RIF resolutions. Board members then approved two settlement agreements by a 6-0 vote.
